### NEW THERAPY GRANTS PROGRAM

The New Therapy Grants Program provides grants supporting the research and development of new therapies in both the academic and commercial settings worldwide to scientific and clinical investigators pursuing innovative, high impact projects that demonstrate a clear path to commercialization from the lab to the patient.

The New Therapy Grants Program was created through a unique partnership between two leading epilepsy non-profit organizations, the Epilepsy Therapy Project and the Epilepsy Foundation. The mission of the New Therapy Grants Program is to drive the development of new therapies for epilepsy, accelerating the advancement of research from the laboratory to the patient.

Priority review will be given to proposals that already have a commercial partner engaged to assist with development and to proposals that have committed or matched funding from the sponsoring institution, commercial partner, or other third party source.

Proposals for research originating from outside the United States are welcome.

### LOI Submission - Deadline September 3, 2010

Applicants interested in the New Therapy Grant Program must submit a Letter of Intent (LOI) electronically using ProposalCENTRAL, an e-grantmaking website.

The proposalCENTRAL system can be accessed at <https://proposalcentral.altum.com>. Once there, if you are already registered, sign in under the 'Applicant Login'. To register, please see 'First Time Users' to setup an account.

You can apply for the desired grant by selecting the New Therapy Program which is listed under the Epilepsy Research Foundation. Simply click on 'Apply Now' and proposalCENTRAL will guide you through the steps necessary for submitting an LOI. ### Funding

\$500,000 is available for funding for the Fall 2010 grant cycle. Although we anticipate awarding grants of \$100,000 on average, we strongly encourage proposals ranging from \$50,000 - \$500,000. Multi-year proposals are also welcome, and will be considered.
